

Peter Ratcliff served with the Edmonton Police Service (EPS) for 34 years, retiring as a Staff Sergeant in 2006.

In 2003, Peter brought forth a serious issue of concern regarding member families being billed for funerals – directly due to Peter's actions, the RCMP refunded expenses to widows back to the early 1990's.
